- 1. The content of this journal is as follows, welcome to actively submit.
 - 1. Life Science and Technology Education / Science and Technology Education Teaching Materials.
 - 2. Robot education, educational robots.
 - 3. Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM).
 - 4. Educational technology, digital learning, digital training.
 - 5. 3D Printing and other emerging technology applications.
 - 6. Education and training of enterprises and science and technology and human resources development.
 - 7. Career planning and development of employees.
 - 8. Organizational Development.
 - 9. Digital learning models and strategies under the digital human resources education and training / human resources training framework. Integration and development with effectiveness measurement, knowledge management, and organizational learning.
 - 10. Other issues related to science and technology and human education.
- 2. The journal is divided into two types: "academic-oriented" and "practical-applied":
 - 1. Academically oriented manuscripts are original academic research.
 - 2. Practical application documents include "Innovative Teaching Materials and Teaching Methods", "Enterprise Practice Sharing", and "New Knowledge Reporting" and other categories.
- 3. Articles submitted must be electronic and use Microsoft Word software for word processing.
- 4. Articles submitted should be incisive and written in accordance with the APA format (7th edition).
- 5. To quote, reprint or translate other people's literature, please obtain the necessary authorization in accordance with the Copyright Law. Any dispute involving copyright or speech liability shall be the sole responsibility of the author.
- 6. The journal adopts a two-way anonymous review system, which is recommended by two (or more) reviewers. Articles shall be published only after the author's revision is confirmed by the review committee and the rotating editor-in-chief.

7. The manuscript of this journal does not pay the manuscript fee, and if the manuscript is adopted, a manuscript authorization letter must be signed.

II. Manuscript Format:

- 1. Academic-oriented manuscripts: a 12,000 word limit per English article. Manuscripts that exceed the word limit will be returned to the author for revision before being processed.
- 2. Practical application manuscripts: a 6,000 word limit per English article. Manuscripts that exceed the word limit will be returned to the author for revision before being processed.
- 3. The first page of the manuscript is the title, abstract (maximum 500 words) and keywords (3-5).
- 4. The page after the abstract is the main text (including figures, annotations, appendices) and references.
- 5. The layout size is A4, the upper, lower, left and right boundaries are 2 cm, and the row height is 1.5 times. Times New Roman.
- 6. Please do not include any information that can identify the author in the manuscript to facilitate the review.

Date of issue: Four issues a year, in March, June, September and December.

Deadline: Annual call for papers.
